Typical Responsibilities

The successful candidate will represent the Company through interaction with environmental regulatory agencies to obtain NPDES/wastewater/storm water permits. The candidate will also conduct negotiations related to enforcement actions or other correspondence with regulatory agencies, typically with the Regional Water Quality Control Boards and/or State Water Resources Control Board. Additional responsibilities will include preparing internal guidance documents and procedures related to Waste Discharge Requirements, NPDES monitoring requirements and SCE's internal Storm Water Construction Program; reviewing and commenting on proposed legislation and regulations; providing guidance to SCE business units on new environmental requirements related to water quality. Assisting business units with training, internal audit preparation and responding to agency notices on all water quality, NPDES and stormwater related issues; performing site or field inspections for compliance with stormwater plans and standards. Developing Construction SWPPP, WQMP, and Corrective Action Plans; and participating in the oil spill notification/response team; some after hours and on call duty required. Candidate will also assist with leading internal teams which cross organizational boundaries to address emerging company issues in the areas of Water Quality, providing interpretative compliance guidance of how water quality regulations apply to specific company operations and projects; and performing other duties and responsibilities.

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
