The San Jose Creek WRP provides primary, secondary and tertiary treatment of 100 million gallons of wastewater per day.

About 35 mgd is reused at 17 different reuse sites. These include groundwater recharge and irrigation of parks, schools, and greenbelts.

The remainder is discharged to the San Gabriel River.
